He is Worthy

The end of the year is always a time of reflection and well as a time to take a breath and consider life. I believe there has never been a better description of life than that given in the "Westminster Confession" which is:

"Man's chief end is to glorify God, and to enjoy him forever."

We can't help considering at this Christmas Season the birth of the King of Kings, the Lord Jesus. We appreciate more than a baby born in a manger. We see what the Gospel of Matthew says of Him:

"And she shall bring forth a son, and you will call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins." Matthew 1:21

In our culture more than ever, the Christian Gospel is under attack, especially the cross. The Bible tells us why in I Corinthians 1:18-21:

For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. For it is written: "I will destroy the wisdom of the wise; the intelligence of the intelligent I will frustrate." Where is the wise person? Where is the teacher of the law? Where is the philosopher of this age? Has not God made foolish the wisdom of the world? For since in the wisdom of God the world through its wisdom did not know him, God was pleased through the foolishness of what was preached to save those who believe.

We are so grateful that God chooses to use believers for His purpose in giving the Gospel to the sick. We plant and water but He gives the increase in His own time. What a wonderful Savior we serve.

This Savior, this King, is the creator. Colossians says all things were made by Him and for Him and by Him all things consist. John (12:41) said Isaiah saw the glory of Jesus when he saw the angelic creatures chanting back and forth, "Holy, Holy, Holy. It's hard to fathom that the creator who is worthy of all praise and glory would rescue sinners with His own life. I don't know if we will ever comprehend the depth of what took place on the cross. The closer we come the grander it will be.

May the God of peace give you joy unspeakable and may we delight in Him daily.

Perhaps the greatest Hymn of all time is "The Old Rugged Cross" which is at the very heart of our message.

This is our lighted cross we carried in with batteries and an inverter to power it. We hung it on a street sign 10 feet high at December Nights at Balboa Park. They say attendance is 300,000 plus. This spot was the heart of the event. I don't believe there has ever been a cross here. Hundreds took photo's and many tracts were handed out. Just before we left police arrived and insisted we take it down. Since we were almost finished we obliged. Another day perhaps.
